

Digital Composite Entry Scoring Procedure

Entries in Class 4805 are judged in two phases.

The "Explanation Board" is judged on Friday afternoon by a panel of 3 members(1 teen and 2 adults) from the Photo Action Team. Each rates the board from 2-5 and scores are added for final number which is entered on Line 1 in Scoring Card found below.

On Saturday morning the finished image goes across the stage/easel and is scored by 3 judges who each rate the image from 2-5 and the final number is entered on Line 2 of the Scoring Card.

Lines 1 and 2 are then averaged and ribbon placing is made.

IF the averaged score is 7.5, 9.5 or 12.5 an additional step is taken.

When the photo score is higher than the explanation board score, the average will round up and become 8, 10 or 13. When the explanation board score is higher than the photo score the average will drop the .5 and become 7, 9 or 12.
